# ISU Cyber Defense Competition

## Default Gateway & DNS

- Your default route (gateway) is the IP sitting at **.254** of your range (see the IP Ranges document). For example, Team 1's gateway is 64.39.3.254
- The netmask is 255.255.255.0 (a /24 subnet)
- The DNS server is located at 199.100.16.100

If your network is set up correctly, you should always be able to ping the DNS server and get a response. Note that due to the way the ISEAGE network is structured you will not be able to ping the real world (e.g. google.com).

## **Proxy Server**

Once on the competition range, you will not have access to the internet. Instead, you must use our proxy server, located at **199.100.16.100, port 3128** 

#### Setting the proxy in a Linux/Unix system

Run the following commands to set the appropriate environment variables:

```
export http_proxy="http://199.100.16.100:3128"
export https_proxy=$http_proxy
export ftp_proxy=$http_proxy
```

This will configure the proxy for just about any command (apt-get being an exception, see the next section). Note that these environment variables will not persist across reboots. You can place these lines at the end of the file **/etc/profile** which will automatically set the variables for you when a user logs in.

#### apt-get

To configure the proxy server for apt-get, edit the file **/etc/apt/apt.conf** (or create it if it does not exist) and add or edit the following lines:

```
Acquire::http::Proxy "http://199.100.16.100:3128";
Acquire::ftp::Proxy "http://199.100.16.100:3128";
```
